

**TOWN OF TROY
SPECIAL BOARD MEETING**

October 27, 2016

Town of Troy chairman, Roger Mack, called the special board meeting to order at the town hall at 3:00 p.m.

Present were Roger Mack, Don Meise, Jeff Lohr, Mary Zins, and Lloyd E. Ballweg.

There was discussion concerning the number of loads of sand required to supply the township during the winter season and when Kel-Ray Trucking should begin the trucking.

Timberline Construction, LLC, Dennis Lichte owner, submitted a bid of \$1,800 to trim and cut the trees on Troy Village Road. He estimated it would take three men approximately thirty-six (36) hours to complete the job. Troy would be responsible to post the road and remove the debris. Lohr made a motion, seconded by Meise, to approve Timberline Construction's \$1,800 bid to trim and cut the trees on Troy Village Road. Motion carried 3-0.

Mack contacted Steve Muchow, Sauk County Highway Commissioner, regarding help in installing the guard rails. Sauk County agreed to assist in that project.

The remainder of meeting was spent working on the 2017 town budget.

The meeting adjourned at 5:05 p.m.
