

TOWN OF TROY SPECIAL TOWN MEETING

September 1, 2026

The special town meeting was called to order by chairman, Bradley Anderson, at 7:00 p.m. at the Town of Troy town hall.

Board members present were chairman, Bradley Anderson; Gregory Sprecher, supervisor; and Douglas Larsen, supervisor. Officers present were Lloyd E. Ballweg, treasurer; and Mary Zins, clerk. There were twenty-one Troy residents present also.

The reason for the meeting was to discuss the town's stance on the forty-acre rule and to adopt a resolution regarding the BECI 765-kV transmission line project.

Troy has the forty-acre parcel rule as does the Town of Honey Creek for any development. A copy of Troy's Development Ordinance has been submitted to the town's attorney for feedback. Per the county's regulation, they require thirty-five acres for any improvements.

Plan Commission chairman, Brian Hanson, is researching if the town could be more restrictive than the county. He is trying to contact Hannah Kroll from the Lakota Group if she would be able to inform him of the state's restrictions.

Residents in attendance were furnished with a copy of Resolution 9-1-26, Landowner Impact Information Request Resolution Regarding the BRCI 765 k V Transmission Line Proposal.

Before being passed, the residents were given the opportunity to voice their opinions regarding the transmission line. Most of the residents were in opposition to the project.

Sprecher made a motion, seconded by Larsen, to pass Resolution 9-1-2. Motion carried 3-0.

Anderson made a motion, seconded by Sprecher, to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried 3-0.

Meeting adjourned at 8:10 p.m.
